LINCOLN PLACE (LP) AND SOLAR PANELS

The club is currently having monthly meetings with LP. These take place on the last Friday of each month via phone hook-up. A Project Control Group (PCG) has been established between the developer and the club. The members are Gary and Taity from the club and Nick and Ben from Lincoln Place. The plan is to discuss and move forward with all the issues that are urgent to put the Lifestyle Village(LLC) in place.

Currently (end of June) all the processes that are necessary for the sale of the club land, (Torrens Title), are in place and the proposal settlement can proceed when the appropriate NSW Dept approves it. The PCG hopes that this is imminent.

The discussions in relation to the appropriate planning that should be adopted to achieve an approval for the LLC by the Mid Coast Council in the shortest time is taking place. As with all things to do with the council these are complicated and tend to take a lot longer than expected. Both LP and the Club are keen to progress this process as soon as possible.

The installation of the second phase of solar panels, (Club House), is now completed and is working well thanks to Brian and the team from Self Sufficiency Supplies. The system is a state -of -the -art battery system that should eliminate power costs of approximately \$35000 per year from our budget moving forward. The Club was hoping to get an Infrastructure Grant from the State Government to cover the cost of this installation but three applications over the last two years have been unsuccessful. As a result, the Emergency Evacuation Centre will proceed with the Club paying for this valuable and necessary project for the Wingham Community itself.
